Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA)

Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA) is eligible for pupils who are 16 or over. This award will be paid according to the







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total taxable household income. Payment is dependent upon attendance, attitude and behaviour.

If your son/ daughter is 16 years of age on or before 30th September 2020, they may be eligible from the beginning of the school term. If they are 16 years of age between 1st October 2020 and 28th February 2021, they may be eligible from January 2021. Please contact Mr Guto Williams if you require any further information.

Spiritual, social, moral and cultural values

Under the terms of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980, parents/ carers have the right to ask for their children to be withdrawn from religious observance and / or religious and moral education. If a pupil is withdrawn the school will make suitable arrangements for the pupil to participate in a worthwhile activity, in consultation with parents.

Parents may also request that their child be permitted to be absent from school in order to celebrate recognised religious events. Advance notice should be given and the absence will be recorded as an authorised absence.

Home Economics

At this time pupils will not able to do any practical work during Home Economics. There is no weekly payment for Home Economics.

Face Coverings

As you are aware face coverings should be worn in communal areas within the school and on school transport (except where a young person is exempt due to underlying health condition or additional support need).

Staff have been working with pupils regarding the wearing and storing of face coverings and all pupils have been provided with a bag for storage. Re-usable face coverings should be changed and washed daily. A supply of re-usable face coverings are available in the school if required.

Unfortunately at this time you cannot send in birthday cakes as we are not permitted to share food with pupils.

Visitors to the school

At this time, parents/carers will not be able to come into the school for meetings. Any contact should be made by telephone or email

If a parent / carer is collecting a pupil who has become ill, they will be asked by the office staff to wait in the school reception maintaining 2m social distancing.

PE

At this time, PE lessons will take place outside. On the days that pupils have PE they should wear suitable PE clothing to school. Pupils will not be able to borrow PE kit from the school. There will be no changing or showering facilities

All pupils have been supplied with stationary and a pencil case for their own use within the school. There is no need for pupils to bring in pencils etc from home
